

SIMPL4ALL PARTNERS MEET IN MARIBOR





With Erasmus+ project on inclusive learning SIMPL4ALL entering the 9th month of the project activities, the partnership led by EnAIP FVG had met at the partners' meeting in Slovenia, which was followed by a 3-day Learning Teaching Training Activities (LTTA) event.

This was the second time since the project launch in January 2022 that the partners Fondazione Progetto Autismo FVG, Cuorementelab Impresa Sociale, Lebenshilfen Soziale Dienste, Zavod Risa, Les Apprimeurs, Logopsycom, Instituto de Tecnicas Educativas -ITE of Madrid and beforementioned EnAIP FVG met face to face to discuss the progress of the project and engage in a peer-to-peer training to share expertise and good practice which will contribute to delivery of high-quality SIMPL4ALL outputs.

The project partners stayed in Maribor from 6 to 9 September 2022.

The meeting and the LTTA took place at the premises of **University of Maribor, Faculty of Education**, which is one of the SIMPL4ALL associate partners. The Faculty of Education of the University of Maribor is one of the most important Slovene tertiary education institutions with high standards of education for primary school teachers, teachers of music and fine arts, inclusive educators, pre-school teachers and sports coaches. Inclusion in Education is one of their popular postgraduate study programs and includes modern methods of learning and teaching such as group discussion, problem-based learning, individual presentations, distance learning, project teamwork, case studies, lectures, and individual theoretical and empirical research (my.UM, 2022).

In this stimulating environment, the 1st joint staff training on simplified language occurred. From 7 to 9 September, staff from the partners' organizations tackled topics such as adaptation of standard texts to Simple language, Easy language, Plain language, accessible books and inclusive editorial work, accessible resources in Vocational Education and Training (VET), learning needs and learning styles of students with different needs, images in Simple languages, etc.

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The LTTA was of special importance for the first project deliverable or Intellectual output 1 (IO1) - the Simple (or SIMPL4ALL) Language Handbook, a Simplified language instruction manual for production and implementation of texts written in simplified language which aims to be suitable for the broadest possible end-user population within the group of VET learners.
