

SIMPL4ALL PARTNERS MEET IN MADRID

With Erasmus+ project on inclusive learning SIMPL4ALL entering the 14th month of the project activities, the partnership led by EnAIP FVG had met at the partners' meeting in Madrid, Spain.

This was the third time since the project launch in January 2022 that the partners Fondazione Progetto Autismo FVG, Cuorementelab Impresa Sociale, Lebenshilfen Soziale Dienste, Zavod Risa, Les Apprimeurs, Logopsycom, Instituto de Tecnicas Educativas -ITE of Madrid and mentioned before EnAIP FVG met face to face to discuss the progress of the project and engage in a peer-topeer training to share expertise and good practice which will contribute to delivery of high-quality SIMPL4ALL outputs.

The project partners stayed in Madrid from 7 to 8 March 2023.

The meeting took place at the premises of Salesianos Atocha School , which is one of ITE NEtwork associate schools. Salesianos Atocha is one of the most prestigious education centers in MAdrid in all the levels of Compulsory Education along with HIgh School and Vocational Training.

In this stimulating environment, The IO1 SIMPLIFIED LANGUAGE MANUAL coordinator, Zavod RISA, showcased the final draft for validation, and after some discussion with the partners all agreed that at the end of March 2023 the Final Version will be completed and downloadable.

The IO2 PEDAGOGICAL TOOLKIT is already in progress and all the partners are working on the main contests. The toolkit will be based on the use of the skills descriptors of an existing European framework (Entrecomp) and to create learning materials, exercises and tips accordingly.

The IO3 coordinator, LHSD, presented the table of contents for the output "Pedagogical mediation 4AII", the approach we will use (Peer Education, Active Learning, Person Centered Planning, Person Centered Approach in Education. Johanna Ilkow introduces the draft and requirements for developing the questionnaire for self-advocacy groups, having as reference John O'Brien' model star (2011), using elements from it (2011).











In relation to IO4-VET VIDEO MODELING 4ALL, Eleonora Rizzi, from FONDAZIONE PROGETTOAUTISMO FVG, participating online, explained what video modeling is, in the context of Autism, providing some examples of videos made by Fondazione Progetto Autismo. She announced the areas of intervention and the fact that the storyboard development is almost completed. Some adjustment has to be made, due to the necessity to move from Autism to other target groups, such as the students enrolled in vocational education and training, with specific learning difficulties or belonging to vulnerable groups. The project coordinator EnAIP FVG is ready to start with casting and video production.
