In the bakery and café, people with disabilities work together with professionals from the service (or restaurant) industry and they thrive in an inclusive and fun work environment.





The project partners were impressed by the concept and design of the café. They enjoyed some tasty pastries and the beautiful art work on the walls, which was created by LebensGroß artists. from an (a LebensGroß) art studio.
